#### STILL LEARNING

Like the rest, we were by nature deserving of wrath. 4 But because of his great love for us, God, who is rich in mercy, 5 made us alive with Christ even when we were dead in transgressions—it is by grace you have been saved. 6 And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, 7 in order that in the coming ages he might show the incomparable riches of his grace, expressed in his kindness to us in Christ Jesus.

Ephesians 2:3b-7

I'm still learning what it means to be saved. I remember the day quite vividly even though it has been nearly 25 years since I surrendered to the saving message of Jesus Christ. I was only a boy, not quite a teenager. I felt a deep conviction in my heart as I began to grow in understanding the implications of Jesus death for my sins. I longed to know him more, and that journey continues still today. I'm no longer the boy who came seeking Christ that day, but I've become a man who is still searching to better know and understand this salvation and the love that God has for all humanity.

Easter reminds us that the work of salvation was completed on the cross of Calvary 2,000 years ago. No amount of good or evil I do can add or take away from what Jesus has already accomplished. I could never pay the debt for my sins. There is only one who could ever make such a worthy sacrifice. God's love and justice were secured in Jesus' death and resurrection. Even though I have heard, read, and preached the gospel of Jesus for many years, it continues to shape and move me. This grace and salvation captivate me. My heart still longs for more of Jesus.

There are so many false saviors and false messages of life. Our eyes and hearts can be easily distracted and prone to wandering, but nothing compares to this story of good news. I've not found a joy that comes close. There is nothing as real, nothing that touches the soul of a person. When we look at the Jesus story we see truth. It is a story of joy and sorrow, death and life. The divine drama of God unfolds to reveal who we are and where we belong. Above all, it teaches us that God loves us beyond what we can ever fully comprehend. He cares for us and is willing even to die in order to rescue and redeem us. Sin and death cannot separate us from His love. We are never too far from His outstretched arms.

This is not a mere intellectual understanding. We are able to feel and experience His presence by His Spirit. In His body, the church, I have seen Him and felt His loving arms. It is an experience that passes understanding. My prayer this Easter is that saints and sinners alike would be awakened to the truth of Christ anew. Be refreshed in the knowing that Jesus is risen and alive, and He is coming again.
