## **Holy Spirit Hovering**

A Paradise Flycatcher (a beautiful red and blue bird with a foot long swaddling red, orange tail) lives and flies by my little house every day. It is a glorious thing to behold, but in my same area during the rainy season live the inswa (thousands of flying termite insects.....the dead ones will fill up a large black garbage bag), and these fill up my floor, my sink, my cups and containers. So this plush Eden-like place has its inswa, mosquitoes, flies, and skinks (lizards). The pests and troubles are everywhere even around my waist and armpits where I recently received about fifty mosquito bites. I have incredible beauty and aggravations in the same space.

So I look at the battle of good and evil here at Namwianga. The Holy Spirit is working and victories are happening. For example, I see Rodgers meeting with over a hundred bicycle evangelists who share the Word with the small village churches near them in the Southern Province. All the little bush churches contributed 20k (\$3.50) to help send volunteer evangelists to two of the baby churches established during the Zambia Medical Mission 2014 to help them in their struggle to survive. So the battle for the Kingdom and eternity is on here in the bush in southern Zambia. I hear singing in the darkness. People sing about Jesus when walking the trails, The Twelve Disciples Group has been revived, the Merritt Friday night singings share the gospel, and I love to sing with Rodgers as we go along in the white land rover, "Great Day When I Was Born Again."

The physical does affect the spiritual at times, so I'm trying to remember Jesus words, "In this world you will have trouble. But take heart I have overcome the world." I try to think of the Holy Spirit flowing, flying, hovering over this place as the Paradise bird does with its great beauty. It lifts my eyes to the heavens and the good and the victory, and I tend to forget the mosquitoes, inswa, and skinks.

And then to top it off, God sends me two women with babies on their backs in the pouring rain to comfort me. They had heard I had gotten many mosquito bites, and they walked thirty minutes one way to bring me a mosquito net to sleep under. People love and care and offer such priceless gifts to show the Holy Spirit working through them.
