My class occurs within the context of a larger life filled with family, friends, activities, and spirituality. I understand and see your child as a unique person made in God's image.

Finally, I want you to know that I am already proud of your kids. They are wonderful people and attest to the many wonderful, loving families here at Hillcrest. I know they aren't perfect and fully anticipate struggles and mistakes, but I see that they are "fearfully and wonderfully made" and that God knows them each by name and loves them all. Your kids are precious to you. I will treat them like they are precious.
