In Zambia to get protection from the flies, inswa, wasps, and skinks, I relax under my mosquito net even during the day. The net circle hoop has a point at the top that directs my eyes upward. I gaze up and see a tent over my entire body and it reminds me of a fog or mist from God to envelope and to tell me not to be afraid of the outside badness. I really do feel all wrapped up with God under my net.

Yesterday at the Kasisbi Church of Christ, I felt the same way of being surrounded, protected by God, and wrapped up with God. The ladies surrounded me on the women's side of the small church as I sat down on the wobbly bench. I felt encircled by the ladies in the small village church and the words on the ceiling logs beckoned my eyes upward, "Read the Bible the Pathway to Life" and "2014 Theme: Be Ambassadors of Christ". Many "snaps" of members working and eating together decorated the walls and surrounded me on three sides. Ba Shepherd's and Ba Leonard's words and songs from God penetrated me as I stepped into God's misty cloud. And wouldn't you know it? After the services, we went out for the traditional line hand shaking where every man, woman, and child shakes every hand, and then the whole one hundred and forty-seven people surrounded us and sang and danced and clapped telling us how happy they were that we were there with them. God's words and his church's actions made me feel protected from the bad things on the outside just like my insect net protects me from the bad creatures on the outside. I really did feel all wrapped up, tied up and tangled up with God as the camp song goes.

Sometimes though, I do have to venture out from the safety of my mosquito net, but I know I am protected and cared for when I am under it. The church, that Jesus died for and gave me, gives a cloud of God to cover me and to show me how to be protected from evils.

Who wouldn't want protection and security in Jesus' family? Ephesians 3:10-11 shows that the church displays the multi-faceted wisdom of God to the authorities in the heavenly realms. The church.....the manifold wisdom of God.....my mosquito net.....my safety net. It's God's wisdom.
