In Praise of Little Things

Truly I tell you, anyone who gives you a cup of water in my name because you belong to the Messiah will certainly not lose their reward.

Mark 9:41

I was only a freshman at ACU when I received a phone call one day from my parents about someone who was in the hospital. Some new members at their church had a mother who lived in Abilene. They asked me if I would mind going and checking on her. I told them I would. When I came to her hospital room, many family members were gathered around her. I'm sure they were wondering who this strange young man was. I explained and they welcomed me. I could see in their faces the stress and pain of what they were experiencing. My words were few. I offered a simple prayer, wished them well, and left. The whole thing was a very small gesture on my part. Later, I received the news that she passed away a few days after our visit. It was in that same conversation that a family member shared with me how significant the visit meant to their mother. Apparently, the simple kindness and care I offered became a channel for God's peace in an hour of anxiety and despair.

Loving someone in Jesus name is never a small thing. I've been in ministry long enough to know that it is not in ourselves, but that God works in the midst of little things to turn them into holy and life giving moments. I've seen it with my own eyes, and I've also been privileged to hear the special stories from others who have been affected by someone's offering of love. It may be something as simple as a hug, a letter, a phone call, a flower, a meal, but when given out of love for Christ it, becomes far more. It happens spontaneously, without much knowledge on our part. But, God knows exactly what a heart needs, and he chooses to use his children to be the way that he connects. The Holy Spirit is able to reach deep inside a person's life.

Scripture is rich with vivid examples of this truth. God used a bush to call Moses to a new life (Exodus 3:2-3). He used a donkey to save Balaam (Numbers 22:33). He used a vine and a worm with Jonah (Jonah 4:7). In Jesus ministry, God chose to use a group of simple fishermen to bear the message of salvation for all of humanity. And, Jesus repeatedly used little children to teach them his plan and message (Matthew 18:2; Luke 18:16; John 6:9). This is the way our God still chooses to work. You don't have to be a gifted speaker to communicate God's love. All you need is a willingness to share your life in Jesus name.
