From Cindy Robinson - As I weave through the tall grass to the nearby village of Wasawonge, the wonders of this place call me to think about the splendors of God's handiwork.....red flowers with no stems and these grow directly out of the sand, the strange calls of tropical birds... but I find that the true wonders of God await me at the village of Wasawonge.....the women!

Beside Irene's mud brick hut with no door, her best carpet.... corn meal sacks hand sewn together.....is rolled out for everyone to sit on the dirt under the mango tree. Now the lesson about the birth of Jesus starts. Either Irene or Elmelda translates. I take off my scarf and twirl it and with clothespins we have a timeline. Linear thinking is hard for Zambians.....so the incarnation must be discussed and shown on the timeline. (Jesus got people to wonder about the same thing "If then David calls him 'Lord' how can he be his son?")

The next part was about twelve year old Jesus growing in wisdom, taller and in favor with people and God. Mwenya said she would ask her grandmother to tell her a story about Jesus everyday so that she would grow in wisdom and in favor with God. Irene and Josephine both said that they would tell Mwenya stories about Jesus every day until next Saturday. These women of Wasawonge hunger and thirst for righteousness. Please pray that their hunger will continue and that they will be filled!
