The storm has given birth to an outpouring of compassion for those who are suffering. Amidst the view of rising water devastating homes and roads the images of hope and grace have also emerged. A common love can be seen. It is a welcome change from the hurt and violence that has been so visible in recent weeks. When we witness acts of kindness and sharing from one to another, God's light shines and we are reminded of life as God intends it to be.

We are a people better together. The waters will recede, but there will be much work still to be done. Let us pray and continue to work to help those who are in need. This is a time for the church to live up to the beloved community that God has called us to be, a beacon of hope in the midst of the storm.
