## The Space Between Us

A cord of three strands is not quickly broken. Ecclesiastes 4:12

A couple of weeks ago, I was blown away as I witnessed my Hillcrest family being "bound together" by hundreds of strands of thread. I did not realize just how much God would use a simple piece of string to touch lives. In the following weeks, I have had several people share with me how this binding experience had a profound affect on them. People who are often isolated from one another moved in and drew near to each other. Kindness and assistance was shared and given as one would help another tie their string to the other. I wish all of you could have seen the excitement and smiles on child and adult alike as we did this exercise. The tiny thread grew to a giant mass of unity.

Bridging the space between us is a very real challenge in a church worship center and in life. Over time, many of us become unaware when a physical and emotional disconnect has developed. When separation starts to happen, we do not always know how or why. Then, once the distance occurs we don't know how to come back together. Yet, this is where the gospel is able to display its power. God is not only the master builder, he is also the master rebuilder and reconciler. The love, grace, mercy, kindness, strength, and forgiveness of Jesus do a work in the space between us that we cannot do.

Last Sunday, I read an excerpt from the book *The World According to Mister Rogers* that spoke to this. He retells an experience that he had as he listened to "the worst sermon…ever imagined" (Rogers, p. 114). It wasn't until he saw a woman near him moved to tears that he realized God had done something special with the words given. He reflects, "Thanks to that preacher and listener-in-need, I now know that the space between a person doing his or her best to deliver a message of good news and the needy listener is holy ground" (p. 115). God can do a lot even with the least, or especially with the least. In Christ, God is working in the space between us. It is a holy work and it is wonderful to behold.

#### Hillcrest's World Bible School 2016 Report

Our WBS paper correspondence ministry had a great year sending out 4,369 studies to Africa and over 200 to those in Texas prisons. African countries include, Malawi, Nigeria, Zimbabwe, Sierra Leone, Uganda, Kenya, Ghana and Liberia. Chikondi from Malawi wrote, "I am 13 years of age and this is my first time to receive WBS. Thank you for this and I desire to spread the Good News of Christ to all those who don't know Him to receive salvation." Amen, Chikondi. That is our goal, too!

The WBS online teaching method is newer but has a growing number of teachers from Hillcrest. To date we have accepted 531 online students from 42 different nations. A few of these have progressed through a number of lessons.

A 3rd WBS teaching method involved distribution of paper lessons to high school students in Ghana. Then WBS scanned those lessons and sent them to us electronically, which we then graded, rescanned and returned electronically. This hybrid model is very new but has potential for certain situations

Last September during ACU's Summit, we hosted our first WBS workshop along with our annual Breakfast. We had over 80 attend from the surrounding area.
