Opening the Door

They gathered in such large numbers that there was no room left, not even outside the door, and he preached the word to them. Some men came, bringing to him a paralyzed man, carried by four of them. Since they could not get him to Jesus because of the crowd, they made an opening in the roof above Jesus by digging through it and then lowered the mat the man was lying on. When Jesus saw their faith, he said to the paralyzed man, "Son, your sins are forgiven."

Mark 2:2-5

This past Sunday, I shared the story of a father who had recently felt the hospitality of Christ. My parents serve at a very small church in a small town on the western edge of Houston. The church building is located in the middle of a neighborhood. They have been making an effort recently to really try to connect to the families living around them. Many of them have never been in church, and a lot of them are dealing with a variety of struggles and hardships. My mom shared with me about a father and his three-year-old daughter. The daughter has been behind in her speech development and doesn't speak very much. After months of coming to the church, the father shared how the church was affecting his family's life. He said that his little girl had shocked him one day when all of a sudden she spoke and said, "Daddy, I love Jesus and I love you too!" He was so moved because she had never spoken like that before. Seeing what God had done, he went on to tell my mother, "Thank you for opening the door for us."

Stories like the one above remind me how we may take for granted how hard it can be to get into the door to see Jesus. I love the imagination of the men who carried their friend to Jesus in Mark 2. I have heard of some creative ways to bring people to Jesus, but I think this one is the winner. The four friends who carried the paralytic to Jesus go unnamed, but their determination is legendary. They could have given up when they came to the house finding no way in the door to see Jesus, but they didn't let that barrier stop them. Instead, they looked above and found inspiration for opening the door.

There are people in your life right now that need the healing mercy of Jesus. Who is going to carry them and lay them at Jesus' feet? In many ways, this story captures the work of the church in our world, to carry people to Jesus. We do not always know how to get through the barriers in front of us, but rather than being discouraged, God is calling us to look above to find inspiration for opening the door. May this be a prayer of the church as we think about our community.
