Stay With Me

Then Jesus went with his disciples to a place called Gethsemane, and he said to them, "Sit here while I go over there and pray." He took Peter and the two sons of Zebedee along with him, and he began to be sorrowful and troubled. Then he said to them, "My soul is overwhelmed with sorrow to the point of death. Stay here and keep watch with me." Matthew 26:36-38

I was twelve years old the first time I can remember seeing my dad weep. The moment is impressed in my memory still. I can see the chair where he was sitting when we received the phone call that my grandfather had died. He had not been ill, so the news was a bit of a shock. For my dad, it was a flood of raw emotions that I had never seen in him before. As unexpected as the news was of my grandfather, I was more taken aback by how this news shook my dad who was always so strong and steady. He was immediately confronted by feelings and memories that took him back to his childhood. Losing his father made him feel overwhelmed with sorrow.

Of all the stories in the Gospels, I find myself so often drawn to Gethsemane. I imagine that the disciples felt something like I did so many years ago that night with my dad. For all the time they had spent with Jesus, they had never seen him guite like this. The garden was a place they would have often gathered for prayer, but it felt different this night. The master preacher and miracle worker was hurting and heartbroken. His plea, "Stay here with me."

Though this scene is one of the darkest in Jesus' life on earth, it gives me comfort. Jesus trusts God with the burden of his heart in prayer. He shares his heart with his friends as well. They don't understand the weight of what is happening, but their failure does not inhibit the work of God's salvation. It actually magnifies the story of our God who redeems the fallen. Jesus still does this today. He longs to share God with us in prayer. He is there on our behalf, bearing the full weight of our sin and shame. His invitation to us is simple, "Stay with me." It is in being with Jesus that our lives are transformed and our hearts are healed.
