

FIFTH GRADE MEMORY VERSES/FAITHFUL SERVANT PROGRAM

(Earn 10 points reciting verses or serving.)

1. MEMORIZE:

“And we know that in all things God works for the good of those who love Him, who have been called according to His purpose.” Romans 8:28

OR:

For at least 3 months, read a chapter from your Bible at least 4 days a week. Keep a record of what you have read. (4 pts.)

2. MEMORIZE:

“No temptation has seized you except what is common to man. And God is faithful; He will not let you be tempted beyond what you can bear. But when you are tempted, He will also provide a way out so you can stand up under it.” I Corinthians 10:13

OR:

For at least 3 months, keep a prayer list and have a daily prayer time. (4 pts.)

3. MEMORIZE:

“I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.” Galatians 2:20

OR:

Read the prayer found in Matthew 6:9-13. Discuss the prayer with your parent. (1 pt.)

4. MEMORIZE:

“Each of you should look not only to your own interests, but also to the interest of others.” Philippians 2:4

OR:

What is God like? 1 Timothy 1:17 and John 4:24. Discuss with your parent. (1 pt.)

5. MEMORIZE:

“Do everything without complaining or arguing. So you may...shine like stars in the universe.” Philippians 2:14-15

OR:

Read a newspaper, magazine, or web site. Find 3-4 articles that deal with hunger and organizations that help fight hunger. Discuss with your parent what you could do to help. (1 pt.)

6. MEMORIZE:

“Whatever is true, whatever is noble, whatever is right, whatever is pure, whatever is lovely, whatever is admirable—if anything is excellent or praiseworthy—think about such things.” Philippians 4:8

OR:

Read Matthew 7:12 and discuss with your parent how you can put this teaching into work in your life. (1 pt.)

7. MEMORIZE:

“I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.” Philippians 4:13

OR:

Read Matthew 5: 14-16 and discuss with your parent 5 ways you can be a light of the world. (1 pt.)

8. MEMORIZE:

“Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as working for the Lord, not for men since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.” Colossians 3:23-24

OR:

With your parent, choose someone to serve. Do 3 acts of service for that person, under the supervision of your parent. (1 pt.)

9. MEMORIZE:

“And as for you, brothers, never tire of doing what is right.” II Thessalonians 3:13

OR:

Read Deuteronomy 5:16 and Ephesians 6:1-3. Discuss with your parent the importance of learning to obey your parent. (1 pt.)

10. MEMORIZE:

“Don’t let anyone look down on you because you are young, but set an example for the believers in speech, in life, in love, in faith, and in purity.” I Timothy 4:12

OR:

List at least 4 gifts/talents God has gifted you. Use one to benefit another person. (1 pt.)

11. MEMORIZE:

“The Lord will rescue me from every evil attack and will bring me safely to His heavenly kingdom. To Him be the glory for ever and ever. Amen.” II Timothy 4:18

OR:

Make a list of ways God has blessed His people. II Chronicles 7:14. (1 pt.)

12. MEMORIZE:

“Remind them to be subject to rulers and authorities, to be obedient, to be ready for every good work, to speak evil of no one, to avoid quarreling, to be gentle, and to show every courtesy to everyone.” Titus 3:1-2
