

FIRST GRADE MEMORY VERSES/FAITHFUL SERVANT PROGRAM

(Earn 12 points by reciting verses and/or serving.)

1. MEMORIZE:

"In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth...God saw all that He had made, and it was very good." Genesis 1:1, 31

OR:

For at least two months, read (or be read to by your parent) a chapter of the Bible at least 4 days a week. Keep a list of your readings in your personal notebook journal. (4 pts.)

2. MEMORIZE:

The Days of Creation

Day 1 – Light

Day 4 – Stars, Sun and Moon

Day 2 – Sky

Day 5 – Birds and Fish

Day 3 – Dry Land and Plants

Day 6 – Animals and People

Day 7 – God Rested

OR:

For at least two months, have a daily prayer time and record some of your thoughts in your notebook journal. (4 pts.)

3. MEMORIZE:

"I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made: your works are wonderful, I know that full well." Psalm 139:14

OR:

Read Psalm 23 with your parent. Draw a picture and discuss illustrating what you learned. (1 pt.)

4. MEMORIZE:

"I will make you a great nation and I will bless you; and all people on earth will be blessed by you." Genesis 12:2-3

OR:

Read with your parent Matthew 10:42. Talk to your parent and think of ways that this scripture can be lived in your life. Draw one of your ideas. (1 pt.)

5. MEMORIZE:

"I will instruct you and teach you in the way you should go; I will counsel you and watch over you." Psalm 32:8

OR:

Help your parent or another adult with a ministry that he/she performs in your congregation. (1 pt.)

6. MEMORIZE:

“You intended to harm me, but God intended it for good to accomplish what is now being done...”
Genesis 50:20

OR:

Make and deliver Encouragement cards for sick, elderly, or shut-in people in your congregation. (1 pt.)

7. MEMORIZE:

“The Lord is good, a refuge in times of trouble. He cares for those who trust in Him.” Nahum 1:7

OR:

Help your parent prepare and deliver a meal to a needy person. (1 pt.)

8. MEMORIZE:

“The Lord is my strength and my song; He has become my salvation. He is my God, and I will praise Him.” Exodus 15:2

OR:

Read Psalm 23 with your parent. Draw a picture and discuss illustrating what you learned. (1 pt.)

9. MEMORIZE:

“Honor your father and mother, so that you may live long in the land the Lord your God is giving you.”
Exodus 20:12

OR:

Read with your parent Matthew 10:42. Talk to your parent and think of ways that this scripture can be lived in your life. Draw one of your ideas. (1 pt.)

10. MEMORIZE:

“Be holy because I, the Lord your God, am holy.” Leviticus 19:2

OR:

Help your parent or another adult with a ministry that he/she performs in your congregation. (1 pt.)

11. MEMORIZE:

“I am the Lord. I am slow to get angry. I am full of love. I forgive those who sin. I forgive those who refuse to obey. But I do not let guilty people go without punishing them.” Numbers 14:18

OR:

Make and deliver Encouragement cards for sick, elderly, or shut-in people in your congregation. (1 pt.)

12. MEMORIZE:

“Hear, O Israel: The Lord our God is one Lord. Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength.” Deuteronomy 6:4-5

OR:

Help your parent prepare and deliver a meal to a needy person. (1 pt.)
