

SECOND GRADE MEMORY VERSES/FAITHFUL SERVANT PROGRAM

(Earn 12 points by reciting verses and/or serving.)

1. MEMORIZE:

“And every man did what was right in his own eyes.” Judges 21:25b

OR:

For at least two months, read (or be read to by your parent) a chapter of the Bible at least 4 days a week. Keep a list of your readings in your personal notebook journal. (4 pts.)

2. MEMORIZE:

“Do not consider his appearance or his height, for I have rejected him. The Lord does not look at the things man looks at. Man looks at the outward appearance, but the Lord looks at your heart.” I Samuel 16:7

OR:

For at least two months, have a daily prayer time and record some of your thoughts in your notebook journal. (4 pts.)

3. MEMORIZE:

“When I am afraid, I will trust in you. In God, whose word I praise, in God I trust; I will not be afraid. What can mortal man do to me?” Psalm 56:3-4

OR:

Read Proverbs 4:20-27 and discuss with your parent. (1 pt.)

4. MEMORIZE:

“The Lord is my shepherd, I shall not be in want. He makes me lie down in green pastures. He leads me beside quiet waters, He restores my soul. He guides me in paths of righteousness for His name’s sake. Even though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil, for you are with me; Your rod and your staff, they comfort me. You prepare a table before me in the presence of my enemies. You anoint my head with oil; my cup overflows. Surely goodness and love will follow me all the days of my life, and I will dwell in the house of the Lord forever.” Psalm 23

OR:

Send thank you notes to adult leaders who have helped you. (1 pt.)

5. MEMORIZE:

“Trust in the Lord with all your heart, and don’t depend on your own understanding. Remember the Lord in all you do and He will give you success.” Proverbs 3:5-6

OR:

Help your parent or another adult with a ministry that he/she performs in your congregation. (1 pt.)

6. MEMORIZE:

“The eyes of the Lord search the whole earth in order to strengthen those whose hearts are fully committed to Him.” II Chronicles 16:9a

OR:

Make and deliver Encouragement cards for sick, elderly, or shut-in people in your congregation. (1 pt.)

7. MEMORIZE:

“Oh Lord, God of our fathers, are you not the God who is in heaven? You rule over all the kingdoms of the nations. Power and might are in your hand, and no one can withstand you.” II Chronicles 20: 6

OR:

Help your parent prepare and deliver a meal to a needy person. (1 pt.)

8. MEMORIZE:

“Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the Lord your God, for He is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and He relents from sending calamity.” Joel 2:13

OR:

Serve during LAFF. (1 pt.)

9. MEMORIZE:

“He has showed you O man, what is good. And what does the Lord require of you? To act justly and to love mercy and to walk humbly with your God.” Micah 6:8

OR:

Send thank you notes to adult leaders who have helped you. (1 pt.)

10. MEMORIZE:

“For I know the plans I have for you, ‘declares the Lord,’ plans to prosper you and not to harm you, plans to give you hope and a future.” Jeremiah 29:11

OR:

Help your parent or another adult with a ministry that he/she performs in your congregation. (1 pt.)

11. MEMORIZE:

“But I will still be glad in the Lord; I will rejoice in God my Savior. The Lord God is my strength.” Habakkak 3:18-19a

OR:

Make and deliver Encouragement cards for sick, elderly, or shut-in people in your congregation. (1 pt.)

12. MEMORIZE:

“This is what the Lord Almighty says: ‘Give careful thought to your ways.’” Haggai 1:5, 7

OR:

Help your parent prepare and deliver a meal to a needy person. (1 pt.)
