

THIRD GRADE MEMORY VERSES/FAITHFUL SERVANT PROGRAM

(Earn 12 points by reciting verses or serving.)

1. MEMORIZE:

“In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and the Word was God. He was with God in the beginning. Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made...The Word became flesh and lived for a while among us.” John 1:1-3, 14a

OR:

For at least two months, read (or be read to by your parent) a chapter of the Bible at least 4 days a week. Keep a list of your readings in your personal notebook journal. (4 pts.)

2. MEMORIZE:

“And Jesus grew in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.” Luke 2:52

OR:

For at least two months, have a daily prayer time and record some of your thoughts in your notebook journal. (4 pts.)

3. MEMORIZE:

“For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.” John 3:16

OR:

Make a poster about the following verse: “Choose for yourselves this day whom you will serve. As for me and my household, we will serve the Lord.” Joshua 24:15. Discuss the meaning of your poster with your parent. Hang it in your home! (1 pt.)

4. MEMORIZE:

“Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.” Luke 6:27-28

OR:

Help your parent or another adult with a ministry that he/she performs in your congregation. (1 pt.)

5. MEMORIZE:

“For where your treasure is, there will your heart be also.” Matthew 6:21

OR:

Make and deliver Encouragement cards for sick, elderly, or shut-in people in your congregation. (1 pt.)

6. MEMORIZE:

“Our Father in heaven, hallowed be Your name, your kingdom come, your will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread. Forgive us our debts, as we also have forgiven our debtors. And lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from the evil one, for yours is the kingdom and the power and the glory forever. Amen.”

Matthew 6:9-13

OR:

Help your parent prepare and deliver a meal to a needy person. (1 pt.)

7. "Sitting down, Jesus called the Twelve and said, 'If anyone wants to be the first, he must be the very last, and servant of all.'" Mark 9:35

OR:

Serve during LAFF. (1 pt.)

8. MEMORIZE:

"Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your strength and with all your mind; and love your neighbor as yourself." Luke 10:27

OR:

Talk with your parent about what talents/gifts you have that can be used to glorify God. (1 pt.)

9. MEMORIZE:

"With man this is impossible, but not with God; all things are possible with God." Mark 10:27

OR:

Participate in two family devotionals. Lead the prayer or song, read scripture, or tell a Bible story. (1 pt.)

10. MEMORIZE:

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. All men will know that you are my disciples if you love one another."
John 13:34-35

OR:

Make and deliver Encouragement cards for sick, elderly, or shut-in people in your congregation. (1 pt.)

11. "Let not your heart be troubled: you believe in God, believe also in me. In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you." John 14: 1-2

OR:

Make and deliver Encouragement cards for sick, elderly, or shut-in people in your congregation. (1 pt.)
